Tommy and Sean are partnering with long-time New Hampshire residents, Maggie and Dan Osborn, to open Barrio Portsmouth. Maggie is also Tommy's sister, and is looking forward to sharing her family's business with her Portsmouth friends and family. "I know it will be a great addition to the community."

Barrio Portsmouth is going into the 3S Artspace at 319 Vaughan Street, and is expected to open this summer. The venue also houses a large, contemporary art gallery, and a flexible performance space that hosts musicians, film, and visual arts events. Barrio will attract visitors and locals alike, as well as provide event goers with tasty options before and after the shows.
